

2.3.6 Elections to the Presidency and the Board of Administration.

2.3.6.1 The Presidency and the members of the Board of Administration are elected by the Congress at its assembly held every four (4) years. Vacancies on the Board of Administration can be filled provisionally upon the proposal of the President, approval by the Board of Administration and confirmation by the Congress.

2.3.6.2 A candidate for the Board of Administration shall be submitted to the CAZOVA Secretariat by the candidate's NF and regional members of origin, **no later than three (3) months prior to opening of the Congress**. Candidates should not have initiated judiciary proceedings against FIVB, NORCECA, CAZOVA or any of its institutions.

2.3.6.3 Candidates must not have been convicted or sanctioned by any court or other judicial body for breaches of the law nor expelled, with lawful cause, from any sports institution.

2.3.6.4 Only elected members of the Board of Administration are eligible to the Presidency. The outgoing President is re-eligible for the Presidency. Candidates for the Presidency shall be submitted to the CAZOVA Secretariat by the respective NF or regional member no later than three (3) months prior to the opening of the Congress.

2.3.6.5 Elections to the Presidency and the Board of Administration are held by secret ballot, unless there are no other candidacies. If the number of candidates is the same as the number of positions to be elected, the elections are deemed to be decided by acclamation.

2.4.1.1 The Board of Administration is composed of seven (7) members to be elected by the Congress.

2.4.1.2 The Congress at its assembly, shall elect seven (7) members from among the candidates submitted by the NFs or regional members, to the Board of Administration for a four-year term.

2.4.1.2.2. The composition of the Board of Administration will be as follows:

President

Vice President – Administration

Vice President – Technical

General Secretary

Treasurer

Two (2) delegates

2.4.1.3 The outgoing members of the Board of Administration are eligible to be reelected to the Board of Administration without presentation by their NF or regional member, provided that their NF or Regional member does not submit written objection to such re-election at least three (3) months prior to the opening of the congress.
